### HOLIDAYS GET THE BEST OF YOU?

Save all year long with our Christmas Club! Our Christmas Club is a savings account which is designed to limit your access until November 1st. This allows you to build up a savings all year for your holiday shopping. Christmas Club accounts may be opened at any time between November 1st and May 1st.

Partial withdrawals will be allowed from the Christmas Club account with a \$5 per transaction fee. Dividends are paid on all open Christmas Club accounts with a balance effective on November 1st of each year. Computation of dividend is on the daily balance. No Dividend will be paid on a Christmas Club closed prior to maturity. After dividends are paid, the Christmas Club balance will be transferred to the member's savings account.

#### Travel Notification:

If you plan to travel out of state, let us know so we can put a travel notification on your debit and/or credit card(s).

#### Mobile App:

Make sure to download our Mobile App. You will have access to your account(s) 24/7. You can check balances, transfer funds, pay bills, deposit checks, and more!

#### Shared Branching:

The CO-OP Shared Branching network allows CFFCU members to visit another participating credit union to access their accounts and transact as if they were in their home branch. Currently, CO-OP Shared Branch is the nation's second largest financial-institution branch network, with more than 5,600 locations nationwide.
