The Community First Federal Credit Union **Undergraduate or Graduate School Scholarship** is only open to undergraduate or graduate students who are members of Community First Federal Credit Union. Community First Staff members may not apply for this scholarship.

DEADLINE: April 1

AVAILABLE TO: Undergraduate or graduate students who are members of Community First Federal Credit Union. Community First staff members may not apply for this scholarship.

AMOUNT: \$500.00 x 1 Scholarship

Community First Federal Credit Union Honorary Community Service Scholarship: All Community First scholarship applicants are eligible for the \$1,000 Honorary Community Service Scholarship. The scholarship committee will choose the top scholarship applicant who exemplifies outstanding community volunteerism and involvement.

Scholarship Criteria and Guidelines

- The **Undergraduate or Graduate School Scholarship** is available to the following students:
 - College undergraduates or graduate school students who are members or have family who are members of Community First Federal Credit Union. **The student or family member must officially reside in the CFFCU field of membership area.**
 - College undergraduate students and graduate students who are attending a community college or university.
- Student grade point average requirement is 3.0 or above.
- Preference will be given to those students that can show participation in community events, volunteerism, and involvement in their community.
- Scholarship payment will be made to the scholarship winner after completion of the first semester of college or trade school and upon proof of matriculation for the second semester. Applicants may be attending a community college, university undergraduate or graduate program.
- Application materials will be placed on the Community First Website and in each of the Community First Branches.
- The Community First Scholarship must be used within 12 months of being received.
- Completed application, transcript, and two letters of recommendation may be submitted in the following ways:
 - Completed on the Community First website through the e-form.
 - Dropped off at any branch location: Lakeview, Howard City, Trufant, or Morley.
